1. We are a nonpartisan advocate for business owners and nonprofits within Pittsburgh's East End
2. We work with the city's Department of Public Works' "Graffiti Buster's Team"
3. We nurture private and public relationships to complete public space improvements such as the revitalization of Broad Street within East Liberty's Business District
4. We work with the local Zone 5 Police to fund and install security cameras at intersections which stream live to the station; currently working to install decorative lighting along four blocks of Highland Avenue
5. We protect the interests of business owners in the East End ensuring that unlicensed vendors are not permitted
6. We are an advocate for responsible development in the East End regarding any and all related legislation
7. We sponsor training sessions and networking events to bring community members and business owners together
8. We hold monthly public safety meetings with the Zone 5 Police Commander to discuss any concerns affecting business interests in the East End
9. We work closely with the East Liberty Historical Society to preserve the memories and artifacts of Pittsburgh's East End

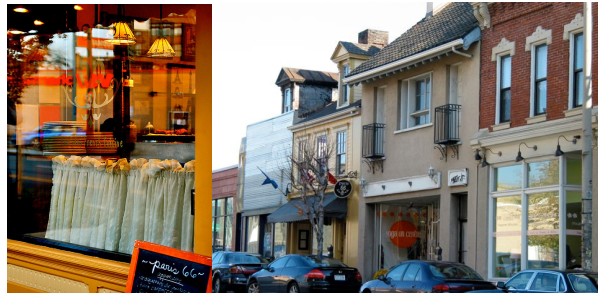
